

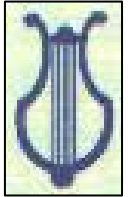

What's this program about?

This program entails three weeks of intensive master classes for clarinetists, vocalists, and pianists. Students will study and perform master works for clarinet, voice, and piano including such works as Brahms Sonatas (see "What can I study?" on the Web for complete repertoire list). In addition to listed repertoire for clarinet, voice, and piano, students will also study solo and chamber music including some works of Carlo Della Giacoma. Italian language classes are also part of the program as well as excursions to such places as Rome, Orvieto, and Assisi.
